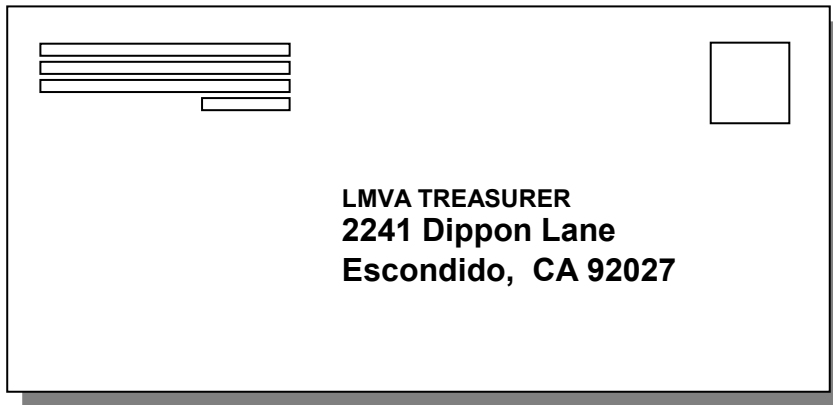

**Zelle** is a United States–based digital payments network run by a private financial services company owned by the banks Bank of America, Truist, Capital One, JPMorgan Chase, PNC Bank, U.S. Bank, and Wells Fargo. The Zelle service enables individuals to electronically transfer money from their bank account to another registered user's bank account (within the United States) using a mobile device or the website of a participating banking institution. There is no fee or charge on the transaction.

Zelle service payees are identified by an association between the recipient's bank account and an **email address or mobile phone number**. Money sent to a registered payee who has an account at a financial institution that is a member of the Zelle network is typically available to the recipient "within minutes". As of 2022 eighty percent of the US population could connect to Zelle through their banking app, with support from over 1600 financial institutions.
